A letter from THE HEAD OF SCHOOL

Dear Friends and Supporters of Episcopal School,

In the 2019-2020 school year, we hosted our first PARK(ing) Day with the Civic Design Center, had our largest garden yet, explored after-school sports, ventured into the city more, expanded our liturgical practices, and held onto some of our favorite traditions. Although last spring brought some unforeseen challenges to our East Nashville community, we continued to thrive. Thanks to the tremendous leadership of the Episcopal School Board of Trustees, the persistence of the Episcopal School faculty and the foresight of several donors, when the COVID-19 pandemic ensued, we were able to pivot quickly to a Distance Learning Program. Each student was equipped with the technology they needed to continue their school work from home, providing the opportunity for uninterrupted learning.

Our story continues to build and it seems like God has a plan for this little Episcopal school. Any time we are met with a challenge we cannot see our way out of, we end up with exactly what we need and more. This continues to be a true practice in faithfulness.

Included within the pages of this report are the names of those dedicated servants of Episcopal School who supported the financial health of this school in a time when our community needed it most. As we embark on the next exciting chapter in Episcopal School's history, let us pause to remember the power of our community. Together we are learning we can do anything, and I congratulate you on the difference you are making for so many children.

As we begin our fifth year, we gratefully serve 90 students Pre-K through the 6th grade. Due to our rapid growth, we made the daring move to the historic Ross School building this summer. This space is one of East Nashville's oldest school buildings. It is our first non-modular school home and holds history and community, two of the driving forces in our school.





PANCAKE SUPPER



A Year Like No Other TRANSITION TO ONLINE LEARNING




When the school was forced to close in early Spring because of the COVID-19 pandemic, the teachers were able to pivot quickly to a high-quality comprehensive Distance Learning program to serve the needs of the students. Having access to technology played a major role in the success of this program. Portable technology was provided for all students, giving everyone the same accessibility to their teachers and subjects. Ipads and ChromeBooks support the integrated technology of the classroom curriculum, helping students take advantage of digital applications that make subjects come alive.



Looking Forward **OUR NEW BUILDING**

The school transitioned this summer from the modular campus to the historic Ross School, East Nashville's oldest surviving school building. This new facility is a testament to our continued growth and gives us the opportunity to expand on an already exceptional program we started five years ago.
